

XPS COOKIE POLICY

We, as XPEDITE Procurement Services S.A.C. (the "Company"), use cookies to improve your experience and make the most of our website (the "Site"). This Cookie Policy ("Policy") aims to inform you about the Company's use of cookies within the scope of applicable data protection laws.

A. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your device when you visit a website. Cookies allow websites to work effectively, remember user preferences (such as language preference or website settings), keep the information on the website up to date, and conduct personalized marketing activities.

Cookies are divided into three by their purposes of use, parties, and lifetime:

(i) Cookies by Parties

- First-Party Cookies: First-party cookies are cookies created by the website visited.
- Third-Party Cookies: Third-party cookies are cookies created by other websites.

(ii) Cookies by Their Lifetime

- Persistent Cookies: Persistent cookies are cookies that are not deleted directly when the internet browser is closed, but are deleted after a certain period of time.
- Session Cookies: Session cookies are cookies that are used to ensure the continuity of the session and are deleted when the user closes the internet browser.

(iii) Cookies by Their Purpose of Use

- Technical (Strictly Essential) Cookies: These are cookies that are necessary for the use of the Site. If the use of these cookies is blocked, certain parts or all of the site may not be accessible.
- Performance (Analytics) Cookies: These are cookies that collect information about how users use the Site. These are used to improve/enhance user experience.



- Advertisement (Targeting) Cookies: These are cookies used to provide personalized content according to the user's interests and to measure the effectiveness of marketing activities.
- Functionality Cookies: These cookies are used to remember your usage preferences on the Site and to personalize your use of the Site.

B. COOKIES USED ON THE SITE AND LEGAL GROUNDS OF COOKIE USAGE

The Site uses performance (analytics) cookies provided by third-party service providers, specifically Google Analytics 4 (provided by Google LLC) and Microsoft Clarity (provided by Microsoft Corporation), to analyze the use and performance of the Site and to improve user experience. These cookies are not strictly necessary for the Site to function. At this time, the Site does not use first-party analytics cookies.

The Company does not sell personal information and does not share personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising or targeted advertising purposes, as those terms are defined under applicable U.S. state privacy laws. The cookies described in this Policy are used solely for analytics and performance purposes.

Under Peruvian data protection law, processing of personal data through cookies requires the user's prior, informed, express, and unequivocal consent, except for cookies that are strictly necessary for the technical operation of the Site.

The details of cookies used on the Site are below:

Cookie Name: `_ga`

Purpose of Use: Performance (Analytics). Used to distinguish unique users and calculate visitor, session, and campaign data for site analytics.

Lifetime: 2 years.

Provider: Google LLC (third party).

Cookie Name: `_ga_<container-id>`

Purpose of Use: Performance (Analytics). Used to maintain the user's session state during navigation.

Lifetime: 2 years.

Provider: Google LLC (third party).

Cookie Name: `_clck`

Purpose of Use: Performance (Analytics). Stores a Microsoft Clarity unique user ID to enable analysis of user behavior on the Site.

Lifetime: 1 year.

Provider: Microsoft Corporation (third party).

Cookie Name: `_clsk`

Purpose of Use: Performance (Analytics). Connects multiple page views by a single user into a single Clarity session recording (session replay).

Lifetime: Session (deleted when the browser is closed or after 24 hours of inactivity).

Provider: Microsoft Corporation (third party).



C. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED THROUGH COOKIES

Your personal data below are processed through cookies as follows:

The personal data processed through cookies on the Site varies by service provider. The following describes the data collected by each service and how it is used.

Google Analytics 4 (cookies: `ga`, `ga <container-id>`): These cookies collect and process the following personal data: a unique user identifier (User ID), your IP address (which may be anonymized depending on configuration), browser type and version, operating system, referring URL, pages visited on the Site, session duration, date and time of your visit, interactions with Site features, search phrases entered on the Site, visit frequency, and language preferences. Google Analytics 4 uses this data to build cross-session behavioral profiles of Site visitors, analyze traffic patterns, and generate aggregated analytics reports. Data collected through these cookies is transmitted to and processed by Google LLC in accordance with Google's privacy policy.

Microsoft Clarity (cookies: `_clck`, `_clsk`): These cookies collect and process the following personal data: a unique user identifier, your IP address, browser type and version, operating system, mouse movements, clicks, scrolling behavior, page offsets, and session interaction data. Microsoft Clarity uses this data to create session replay recordings and heatmaps that capture your interactions with the Site in detail, including the specific content you view and interact with. This constitutes behavioral profiling of your use of the Site. Data collected through these cookies is transmitted to and processed by Microsoft Corporation in accordance with Microsoft's privacy policy.

Data collected through these cookies is processed by Google LLC and Microsoft Corporation to provide analytics services to the Company, in accordance with their respective privacy policies.

If you are a resident of a U.S. state with applicable privacy legislation, the categories of personal data collected through cookies may be classified as "identifiers," "internet or other electronic network activity information," and "inferences drawn from the above" under applicable law.

D. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTION THROUGH COOKIES

Your personal data mentioned above are collected by automated methods through cookies.

E. SHARING OF PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED THROUGH COOKIES

The Company shares personal data collected through cookies with the following categories of third-party service providers:

Analytics Providers. Personal data collected through cookies is transmitted to and processed by Google LLC (for Google Analytics 4) and Microsoft Corporation (for Microsoft Clarity) for the purpose of providing analytics services to the Company, as described in Section C above.

Advertising Networks. The Company does not currently share personal data collected through cookies with advertising networks or advertising exchanges. We do not sell or share your personal information for purposes of targeted advertising, as those terms are defined under the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA/CPRA) or similar U.S. state privacy laws.

Location of Data Processing. Personal data collected through cookies on the Site is primarily processed in the United States. Personal data may also be processed in Peru, where the Company is incorporated. The processing of personal data by third-party service providers is governed by those providers' respective privacy policies and applicable data protection laws.

F. DISABLING OF COOKIES

Most browsers offer different ways to protect your privacy. For instance, you may allow first-party cookies or block third-party cookies. You may also configure your browser to refuse cookies, delete existing cookies, or notify you when cookies are being placed.

G. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You have several rights under applicable data protection laws. We try to make it easy for you to take control of your personal data and exercise your legal rights below. Your rights are as below:

- Right to Access: You have the right to know how your personal data has been collected and processed, what data exists in our systems, and for what purposes it has been processed. This information may be accompanied by a copy of the requested data.
- Right to Correction (Rectification): You have the right to request a correction on incorrect or incomplete personal data of yours.
- Right to Erasure (Right to Be Forgotten): You have the right to have your personal data permanently deleted. But this is not an absolute right to require all personal data to be deleted. We will consider each erasure request in accordance with the requirements of applicable laws.
- Right to Restriction of Processing: You have the right to block or suppress your personal data being processed.



- Right to Opt Out. Under applicable U.S. state privacy laws, you may have the right to opt out of the sale or sharing of personal data for cross-context behavioral advertising, targeted advertising, or profiling in furtherance of decisions that produce legal or similarly significant effects. As noted in Section E above, we do not currently sell or share your personal data for such purposes..
- Right to Non-Discrimination. We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your privacy rights.
